White Settlement ISD (WSISD) is a growing suburban school district with nearly 6,000 students living in White Settlement and part of West Fort Worth.

Located on the west side of Tarrant County, WSISD is convenient to multiple venues including the impressive Fort Worth Cultural Arts District, which features a science and history museum, two world-renown art museums and numerous performing arts facilities.

WSISD includes four “Exemplary” elementary campuses, a “Recognized” intermediate school, a middle school, high school, alternative campus and the “Recognized” Fine Arts Academy.

- **CAPTURING KIDS’ HEARTS** - A teachers ability to build relationships with students is vital to increasing that students confidence and academic achievement. In the past 4 years, over 100 instructors have attended this nationally-acclaimed training program to help accomplish those goals.
